

T'eqt'aqtn'mux




OATH OF OFFICE – CHIEF

Before the members of the *T'eqt'aqtn'mux* (crossing place of people), a Nlaka'pamux Nation community with Indigenous rights, responsibilities, and authority over its lands and resources within its community caretaker area, today known as the Kanaka Bar Indian Band, I, **JORDAN SPINKS**, pledge to uphold the honor and duty vested in me as Chief of the Kanaka Bar Indian Band in accordance with the below:

I, **JORDAN SPINKS**, do solemnly commit to the best of my ability, knowledge and skills:

- A. to uphold the responsibilities of my office as specified in Governance Code;
- B. to respect and discharge my duty in compliance with the laws, policies and traditions of the Kanaka Bar Indian Band;
- C. to work diligently and in the utmost good faith for the benefit of the Kanaka Bar Indian Band;
- D. to avoid any situation where my self-interest would conflict with the interests of the Kanaka Bar Indian Band and to promptly disclose to elected Council members the details of any conflict of interest, whether real or perceived;
- E. to work for the people of the Kanaka Bar Indian Band and in the best interests of all members equally, without favor to any individual or family;
- F. to build a consensus for decisions and to respect all other Council members and employees of the Kanaka Bar Indian Band;
- G. to advocate on behalf of our community at all levels, including with First Nations, provincial and federal governments, and international organizations; and
- H. to treat all people with respect, including those not from the Kanaka Bar Indian Band with whom I have contact in the conduct of my office on behalf of the people of Kanaka Bar Indian Band.
