



# Kanaka Bar Indian Band COVID-19 Response Survey

Kanaka’s Council is inviting you to participate in a virtual COVID-19 discussion. We will be hosting a virtual COVID-19 meeting and gathering your feedback on community-wide COVID-19 measures with the results of this survey. It has been 8 months since BC had its first COVID-19 positive case and we have all experienced a global “first wave” and the protective measures. Now we are all now facing a second wave – regardless of where we live. We would like to gather your opinion on community measures that can be implemented to ensure that the needs of families and individuals are met, and that we remain safe and healthy through the second wave of COVID-19. The results of this survey will help to inform Kanaka Bar of the community-wide measures that should be taken in response to the COVID-19 pandemic. In addition to safety measures which have already been taken in the community, the responses to this survey will help us to identify areas in which we can support the safety and well-being of all Kanaka Bar members as COVID-19 cases increase throughout the province and the region.
