

JOB POSTING: Junior Land Guardian – Kanaka Bar Band

Kanaka Bar is looking for regional youth to work with the Cumulative Effects Coordinator during fieldwork for initiatives to restore and protect our community's lands (Cumulative Effects Initiative, Land Guardian Program Development, and Indigenous Protected and Conserved Area establishment). The work involves travelling throughout Kanaka's Territory for various types environmental fieldwork (e.g., water testing, ecosystem restoration), archaeological research (e.g., mapping old trails, pictograph/petroglyph documentation/analysis), and other tasks, as needed (e.g., acquisition of drone photos/videos).

Applicants should have an interest in learning more about Kanaka Bar's cultural and natural heritage, as well as be physically fit to spend a day hiking. Successful applicants will receive training in environmental and archaeological research methods, as well as GIS/GPS (mapping). This has the potential to turn into a full-time, long-term position.

There is much flexibility with this position, and we will plan daily activities and scheduling around successful applicants' interests and availabilities.
