- Process cash register payments by cash, cheque, debit, credit card, and gift card.
- Balance the cash register, handle and calculate financial paperwork.
- Maintain inventory and cleanliness.
- Process and pack orders for local delivery.
- Deliver food orders in the community, as needed.

- Strong attention to detail, time management, and problem-solving skills.
- Ability to work independently and follow accountability systems.
